(Hockey Night in Canada theme will play as characters take stage lights on @ end)

Rob: Good evening, New York City. My name is Rene Trembley.

Paul: Bonjour. I am Phillip Rousseau.

R: We are here as French-Canadian hockey ambassadors.

P: This is our first time outside of Quebec. (Big cheer)

R: And first time away from our women! (Big cheer)

P: Here to promote the greatest game in history.

R&P: HOCKEY!!! (Big cheer then series of 3 hockey poses that continue through scene)

R: The hockey strike put a damper on fans spirits.

P: So, we are here to get you excited about hockey again!

R: OR for the first time!

P: Madison Square Garden!

R: New York Islanders!

P: When was the last time you saw men checking each other into boards?

R: Seen the way a man handles a stick to get that puck in the hole?

P: Goal Rene. *Goal.*

R: It is my second language.

P: New York, you have two teams,

R: Three if you count Buffalo.

P: Buffalo is close to Toronto Ontario. (Toronto said with disdain)

R: Buffalo is better.

P: More culture in Buffalo.

R: The men are more attractive.

P: The *people* are more attractive.

R: Second Language.

R&P: HOCKEY!!! (Actions)

R: If you are man,

P: And Canadian,

P&R: Hockey is in your blood.

R: And it gives you rock hard nipples.

P: The cold keeps his nipples at a permanent ultra-sensitive level. Although it sometimes makes his nipples sore.

R: Sore. (Shaking head in agreement-look at each other longer than comfortable-turn away quickly)

P&R: HOCKEY!!! (3 actions)

P: We wish we could have brought our equipment to show you..

R: But your border, so strict, they not allow us to bring our skates into country,

P: Fascists!

R: Our blades are a weapon only on the ice!

P: Yes Rene! That Yankee border guard is lucky was not on the ice with us and,

R: Our two men advantage,

P: Doodle dandy would never get through *our* attack zone!

R: We would bare back any American trying to score on us!

P: Back check Rene! Back check!

R: Second language. We would do anything to stop an American invasion on our ice!

R: (Calming him) *But*, it was American filmmakers that made us love hockey.

P: Slap Shot.

R: The Mighty Ducks.

P: The best however, (Look into each other's eyes)

R: Rob Lowe

P: Patrick Swayze.

R&P: YOUNGBLOOD!

P: It shows the true passion of the game.

R&P: HOCKEY!!! (Actions)

R: You can smell the locker room sweat from the screen!

P: And the initiation scene where Rob's pubic hairs get shaved by Patrick Swayze and his teammates.

R: So true to life.

P: Rene shaved my pubes.

R: Phillip shaved mine. Every Friday night for the last 10 years. (Put arms around each other, notice intimacy, break off)

P&R: HOCKEY!! (actions)

P: As with most Canadians,

R: We hate Toronto.

P: Even people that live in Toronto,

R&P: Hate Toronto.

R: Their hockey team is Toronto Maple Leaf's. (Disgusted faces)

P: The team with the smallest sticks. (Each take out a small, plastic hockey stick)

R: The Leaf's are terrible.

P: When you think of them you can't help but go, (Letting sticks go limp)

R: Limp for 35 years!

P: While Montreal has been in the finals 35 times!

R: This year, 2013, we are ranking 3rd!

P: We have come to watch the Canadians play the Rangers.

R: We are so excited to watch the puck drop in Madison Square Gardens!

P: Can Zambonis clean American blood from rink??

R: There will be high-sticking, (getting sticks out again and sexual)

P: There will be stick-handling, (playing with sticks)

R: Cross checking,
